  - Assign volunteers to their specific job when they get there. They need to be there 1 hour before the event starts
  - Have a clean up crew
  - Marlin suggested food 5:30pm-6:30pm & meet the staff from 5:30pm-7:00pm
  - Food needs to be ready for staff at 4:45pm (no pre-made plates, send the plates, a roaster, coleslaw, bag of buns, chips & cookies to the staff room & they'll serve themselves)
  - Remind families that there is a cost for the event

- Put chips at the end of the line with a double table to make the line move faster
- Maybe stamping peoples hands when they've had their food to keep better track of who has been fed
- Plan for 800 people in 2019
- Kira Earl & J'Ana Smith volunteered to write 12 thank you notes for our sponsors
- A debrief meeting is needed with those involved to finish everything up keep the school in the loop so they know what is needed from them
