# Principal's report - Marlin Hogg

- Healthy eating programme feeding 320 kids daily, providing healthy alternatives as well as
  taste testing new foods. Students are settling in to classes better and learning better as a
  result. Multiple teachers are reporting positive differences. RES has received funding approval
  for another year to run the programme.
- As a result of the success of the programme, more help will be needed to run the Healthy Snack Fridge. The fridge has been well supported by our community sponsors but it will need more.

- RES is running at 122% capacity. Six new classrooms (portables) have been approved and will be added to the first wing of the existing portables. Two junior high classes will be held in the new portables & the two schools are still in the planning stages as to the logistics.
- Please encourage those you know to register for kindergarten.

## Year end Healthy Snack Fridge report - Karen Salmon

- 28,243 snacks were provided through the fridge this year. That is 8000 more than last year.
- Volunteers will be needed on a daily basis to keep the fridge stocked. Some of the work can be done at home.
- Considering a compost bin for organic waste.
- Two Healthy Snack Fridge Co-ordinators have been proposed (non elected positions), one to run the financial side and the other to be a volunteer coordinator for the fridge.
- A mailshot will be going out to ask for monetary donations with a donation box at the office door so no need to hand it in at the office. A suggestion was made for etransfers to be available for donations - this will be looked in to.
